Current second year teachers did not complete the normal phases of a first year teacher during spring 2020 Incomplete rejuvenation and reflection phases (Moir, 1999)

Current first year teachers did not complete clinical experience in spring 2020 due to school closures Analysis of the MEES Teacher Candidate Assessment on hundreds of teacher candidates has revealed potential learning losses in the following areas:

Administrator Questions to Support Teacher Thinking

How does your understanding of student needs and interests influence your instructional planning?

What strategies have you planned to promote student thinking, problem-solving, and communication?

How many/which of your students understood what you taught today? ... What evidence do you have?
